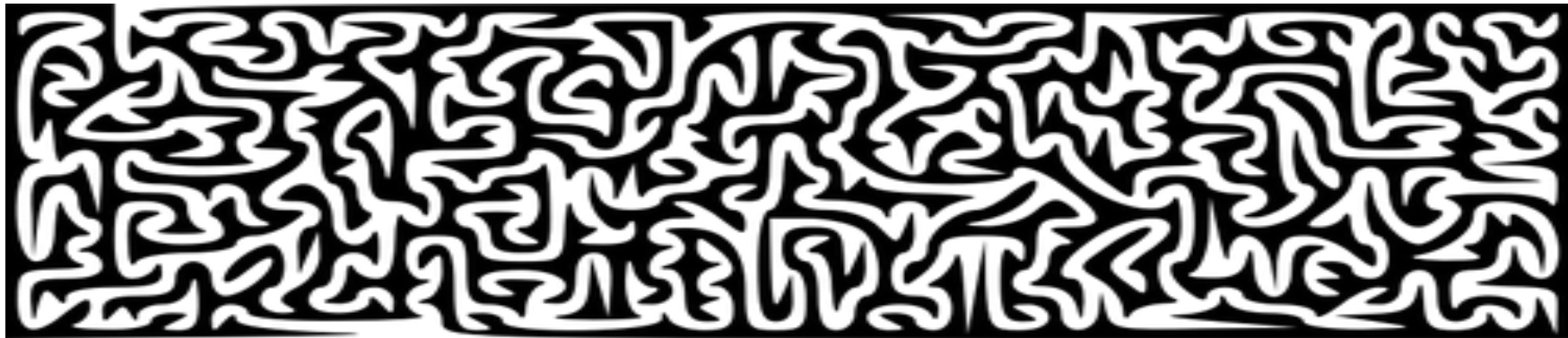

Resolution



What is it?

- Proposal for review/consideration to assist an association to address priorities identified by members

Resolution Author

Who can write a Resolution?

- Any member of WSNA



Resolution → General Assembly Agenda

- Resolution generated by WSNA Council, Cabinet, or Committee



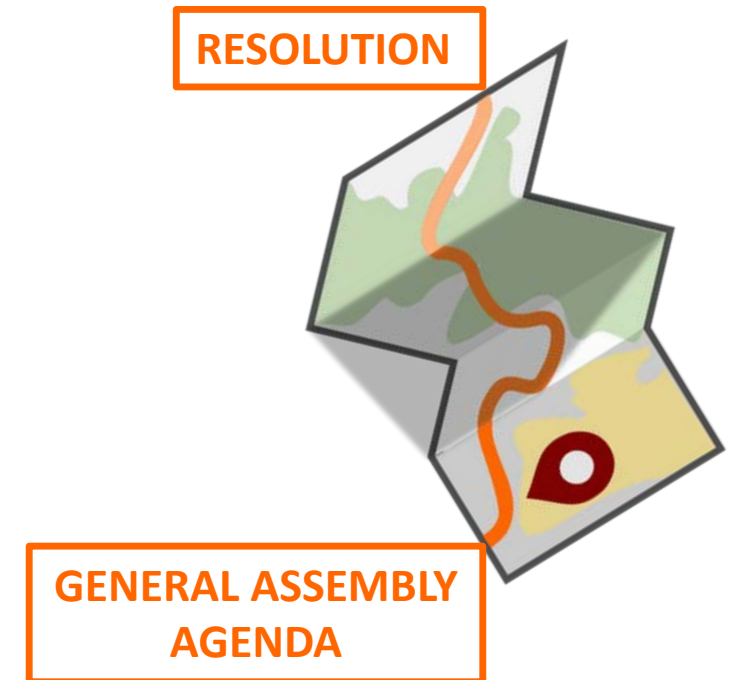
- Bylaws and Resolutions Committee reviews



- Clarification as needed



- Adopt for presentation at General Assembly




Resolution Format

Two parts of a resolution:

1. Statement of **problem** to be solved
 - Written as a “WHEREAS” clause
2. Proposed **solution** to the problem
 - Written as a “RESOLVED” statement



 The “RESOLVED” section of a resolution is complete in itself; it does not depend on the “WHEREAS” clause to give it meaning.



Resolution Journey....Next Steps

After passed in WSNA General Assembly:

- Board of Directors assign the Resolution for implementation
 - To one of the designated Councils/Cabinet/Committees
- Next opportunity to provide “resolved” statement(s) status
 - Biennial Convention (2021)
